## SELLER'S QUALITY CONTROL REQUIREMENTS

Seller shall maintain quality controls that ensure all goods and services conform to Contract requirements whether manufactured or processed by seller or procured from seller's subcontractors or vendors. The Seller is responsible for performing or assuring all inspections, tests and calibration necessary to substantiate that the goods or services furnished conform to Contract requirements. Records of conformance shall be maintained on file at the seller's facility and made available or provided for review by Buyer upon request. Seller's facilities and quality controls are subject to Buyer review. Seller shall take prompt action to correct conditions that have or could result in goods or services that do not conform to contractual requirements.

If the product specification has a Qualified Products List (QPL), or Qualified Manufacturers List (QML) then the manufacturer of that product must be listed on the QPL/QML.

If Seller is a Distributor or other than the True Manufacture (OEM), then the true manufacturer's name and location (city and state) shall be identified within Seller's shipping documentation.
