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FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION REQUIREMENTS - DELIVERABLE DOCUMENTATION

In accordance with Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Federal Aviation Regulations (FARs) Part 145 and Sections 21.607, 43.13, 45.14, and 45.15; parts must be identified with at least one of the following, as applicable:

- 1) FAA form 8130-3, "Authorized Release Certificate ", "Airworthiness Approval Tag"
- 2) FAA Technical Standard Order (TSO) markings on part and associated TSO certification, in accordance with FAR Section 21.607.
- 3) FAA Parts Manufacturing Approval (PMA) markings on part and associated PMA certification, in accordance with FAR Section 45.15.
- 4) FAA Production Certificate statement on associated shipping documents that indicates the part was produced under FAA Production Certificate.
- 5) Certificate of Conformity from the Supplemental Type Certificate (STC) holder, shipment of parts based on a STC must be shipped with documentation referencing the STC.
- 6) Maintenance Release Documentation with all applicable information per FAR Part 43, Appendix B, and accomplished by those authorized to perform maintenance, preventive maintenance, and alterations in accordance with FAR Part 43.
