The serialization scheme shall be approved in writing by Buyer's Authorized Procurement Representative.

If D210-11000-1, Requirements for Test and Records of Process Sensitive Parts, or D210-10302-1, Control Requirements for Critical Bearings and Clutches, or D210-10558-1, Control Requirements for Self-Lubricating Bearings, is specified on the engineering design, and D210-13613-1 or D210-13613-2 are not specified on the engineering design, parts shall be serialized as follows: Seller's "Supplier Code Letters" provided by Buyer's Authorized Procurement Representative, shall precede each serial number assigned by Seller. Serialization will start with serial number 101 and continue consecutively regardless of dash number, unless otherwise specified on the engineering design.
