TRACEABILITY REQUIREMENTS

a) Raw Material - Applicable documentation (e.g. test reports, shipping documentation, certification) shall provide traceability for the product received. Traceability may be by lot number, heat lot, serial number, or batch number. When identification and serialization can not be applied to the product, each shipping package or shipping container shall be marked to provide traceability identification.

(b) Active Electronic Components - Seller shall identify each assembly and applicable documentation (e.g. test reports, shipping reports, or certifications) to show clear traceability to the manufacturing lot/date code for the active electronic component(s). Unless otherwise directed by the specification, when the size does not permit marking of individual items, Seller shall label each package or box.

Duplicate documentation is not required for subsequent delivery of goods that are the same material/component certifications as the latest First Article Inspection (FAI) item.
