Government Source Inspection (GSI) is required on this Purchase Order/Contract prior to invoiced product shipment to The Boeing Company. When GSI authorization is delegated to the local government Quality Assurance Representative (QAR), the contractor shall notify the QAR immediately upon receipt of this Purchase Order/Contract. When GSI has not been delegated to the local QAR, the contractor shall notify the NASA-Kennedy Space Center (KSC) Procurement QAR immediately upon receipt of this order. The contractor shall also notify the responsible QAR at least five (5) working days in advance of the date goods or services will be ready for tests, inspections, or other Mandatory Inspection Points (MIPs), as required and indicated in the Purchase Order/Contract. MIPs are designated by The Boeing Company's Quality Engineering and the Government in accordance with The Boeing Company Special Quality Assurance Clause No. 817. Evidence of GSI must be indicated by the QAR's stamp or signature on the contractor's shipping document. (Reference The Boeing Company Special Quality Assurance Clause No. 877.) In the event the QAR cannot be contacted, notify The Boeing Company's Subcontract Administrator immediately. For installation / modification contracts performed on KSC or Cape Canaveral Air Station, evidence of GSI accomplishment must be indicated by the QAR's stamp or signature on the Purchase Order or related document(s). All work on this Purchase Order/Contract is subject to inspection and test by the Government at any time and any place.
