

Q832 Raw Material Certification and Test Results - rev 3/6/01

The Seller shall include a Certification of Raw Material and Test Results, signed by an authorized company representative, with each invoiced product shipment to The Boeing Company.

The certification must confirm that the furnished lot of material has been tested per the applicable procurement specification(s) and meets or exceeds the contractually-specified limits. The certification shall also include the specification(s) and applicable revision(s) thereto, to which the material is certified. When quantitative limits are established, and contractually required to be reported to The Boeing Company, the certification must contain the actual test values obtained. If the Seller is not the manufacturer, the certification package must also contain a true copy of the certificate provided by the manufacturer, i.e., forging billet stock provided by a melting source.

The Seller must perform all tests where the manufacturing process has altered the properties from those which were certified by the original manufacturer. The submitted Raw material Certification and Test Results data must reflect the condition of the delivered material.

The Seller shall perform a chemical analysis check of metallic material, converted by any method, from each melt, heat, or lot, and submit the results in the Raw Material Certification and Test Results data submitted to The Boeing Company.
