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BIDDER'S SIZE AND POINT OF MANUFACTURE

Bidder's proposal will state the number of employees of Bidder, the place of manufacture of the goods (or performance of the services), whether Bidder is a large or small business pursuant to the rules of the Small Business Administration, and, if manufactured, performed, or subcontracted outside the U.S., the export license number and whether Bidder is an affiliate of a U.S. firm.

The Offeror is hereby notified that, under 15 U.S.C. 645(d), any person who misrepresents a firm's business size or socioeconomic status as defined in FAR 52.219-9 in order to obtain a contract to be awarded under the preference programs established pursuant to sections 8(a), 8(d), 9 or 15 of the Small Business Act or any other provision of Federal law that specifically references section 8(d) for a definition of program eligibility, shall:

- a. Be punished by imposition of a fine, imprisonment, or both;
- b. Be subject to administrative remedies, including suspension and debarment; and
- c. Be ineligible for participation in programs conducted under the authority of the Act.

Socioeconomic status for Boeing subcontracts includes the list of concerns in FAR 52.219-9 as well as women-owned small business concerns, Historically Black College or University or Minority Institutions, Indian organizations or Indian-owned economic enterprises, rural area small business concerns, foreign business concerns, joint ventures, and/or a large minority business concerns or women-owned large business concerns.
