 - 1. DCMA DODAAC that Supports Supplier, along with QAR name, phone number and e-mail address
 - m. CSI/GSI Status
- 3. Boeing shall provide Seller a completed copy of DD250 with proprietary information redacted.
- 4. Seller shall notify DCMA QAR when a completed DD250 is available in WAWF. Shipment shall not occur until a DCMA approved DD250 has been completed in WAWF.

In the event a product is ready for shipment, but appropriate shipping instructions have not been received, Seller should contact Buyer's Authorized Procurement Representative for instructions. Seller shall comply with the PS1352 Military Section.
