Early Delivery

Notwithstanding the prohibition against early delivery elsewhere in this contract, Buyer authorizes and encourages Seller to deliver the goods earlier than its promised delivery schedule incorporated in this contract, however, not earlier than Buyer's required delivery schedule, which is also incorporated in this contract. In addition, notwithstanding anything to the contrary elsewhere in this contract, the payment-due date for deliveries made in accordance with this clause shall be computed from the latest of Buyer's required delivery date, the actual delivery date, or the date of receipt of a correct invoice.
